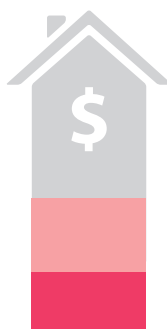

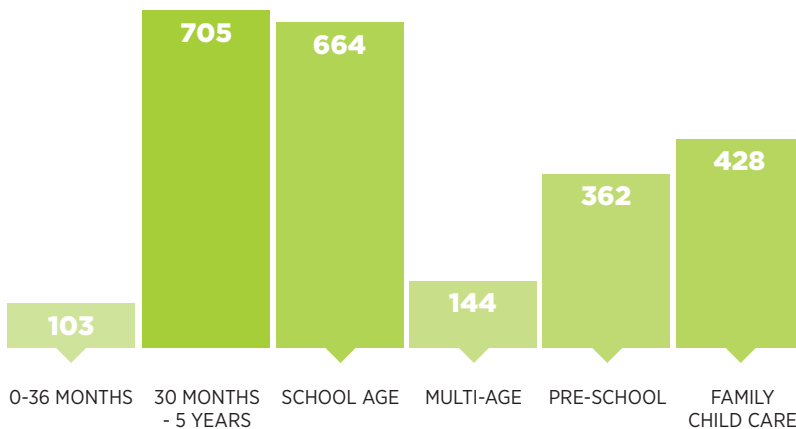

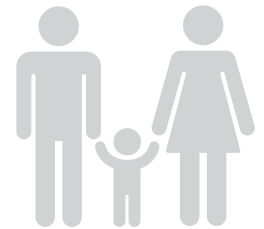

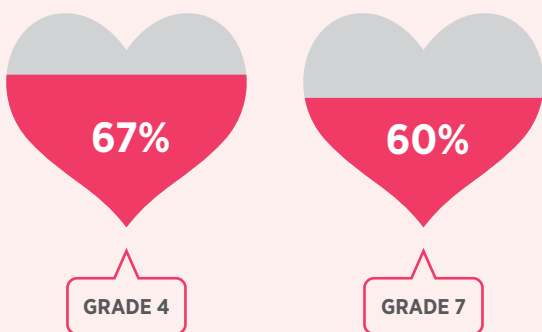

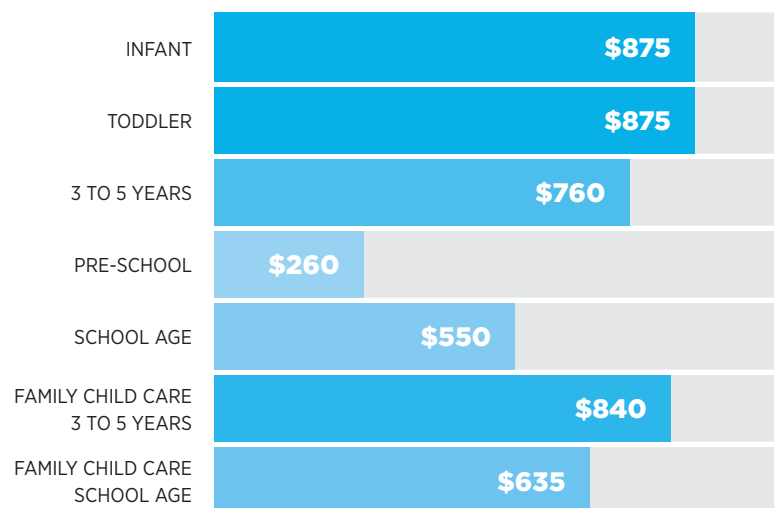
Percentage of children who have medium to high well-being
